Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letters of November 17 and December 6, 1965, wherein you request an exception to Rule 107 (d) (2) to permit the production of gas from your Majority Federal Well No. 8 located in Unit 2 of Section 7, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, West Henshaw Grayburg Extension, Eddy County, New Mexico, through 4 1/2 inch casing.

Inasmuch as a recent test of the well indicated a dry gas with no liquids being produced, flowing the well through the casing should present no production problems nor cause waste. The Commission, therefore, has no objection to flowing the well through the casing and exception to Rule 107 (d) (2) is hereby granted. The Commission does reserve the right, however, to rescind this order in the event that inefficient flow is later indicated.
