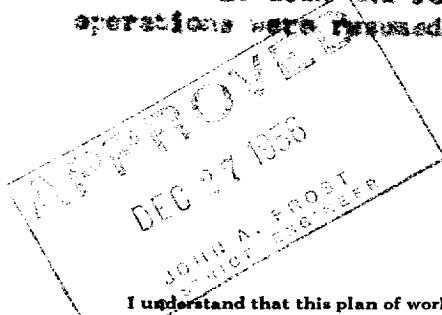

DETAILS OF WORK

On December 18, 1956 we ran 513' (15 joints 4-2 new and 1 joint 2-1 used) 10 3/4 O.D. 32.75 lb. third. 5-16 seamless casing to 513' and cemented with 50 sacks class cement. After allowing to stand cemented for 48 hours, a drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. A shut-off proved complete drilling operations were resumed. Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Co.
