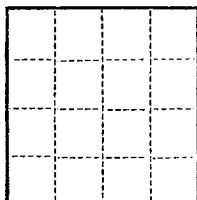

DETAILS OF WORK

As per our conversation we spotted 20 sax cement plug at bottom of hole (3620) and mudded back to 2475', set wooden bridge plug 2475' and spotted 10 sax cement plug and mudded to 2100' spotted 10 sax cement plug, pulled all of 7", mudded hole back to 1175' spotted 10 sax cement plug, mudded back to 515' set 10 sax cement plug, knocked off 8 5/8" at 397' pulled same, mudded to top, set 5 sax cement plug on surface and set marker and description, cleaned up location.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
