DETAILS OF WORK

On March 2, 1960 we ran 2893' (95 joints) of 5 1/2" OD 8rd thrd 14# new JS casing to 2895' and cemented with 150 sacks neat cement.

After standing cemented for 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer.

As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Note: No surface water encountered in this well.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
