I plan to drill a 2950' Grayburg sand test, using cable tools all the way.

I will set 10 3/4" surface casing in anhydrite near the top of Salt, at approximately 470' with 75 sacks.

8 5/8" will be cased around 2230' for a Queen water shut off.

A 3 1/2" production string will be cemented at approximately 2890' with 100 sacks.

All casing will be run and cemented using procedures approved by the U. S. Geological Survey.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

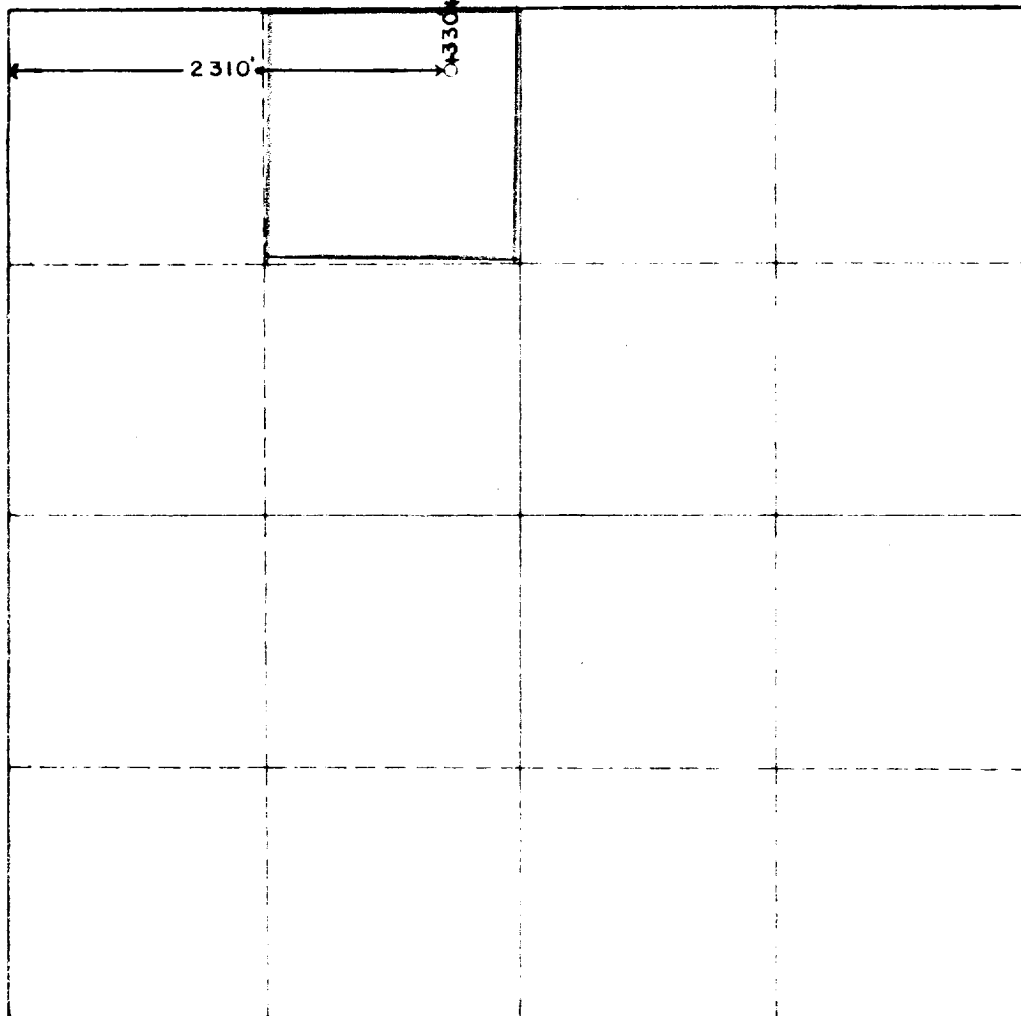
