Drill 6 3/4" hole to 3050' and cement 6.5#, 2 7/8" casing w/210 ex. cement.

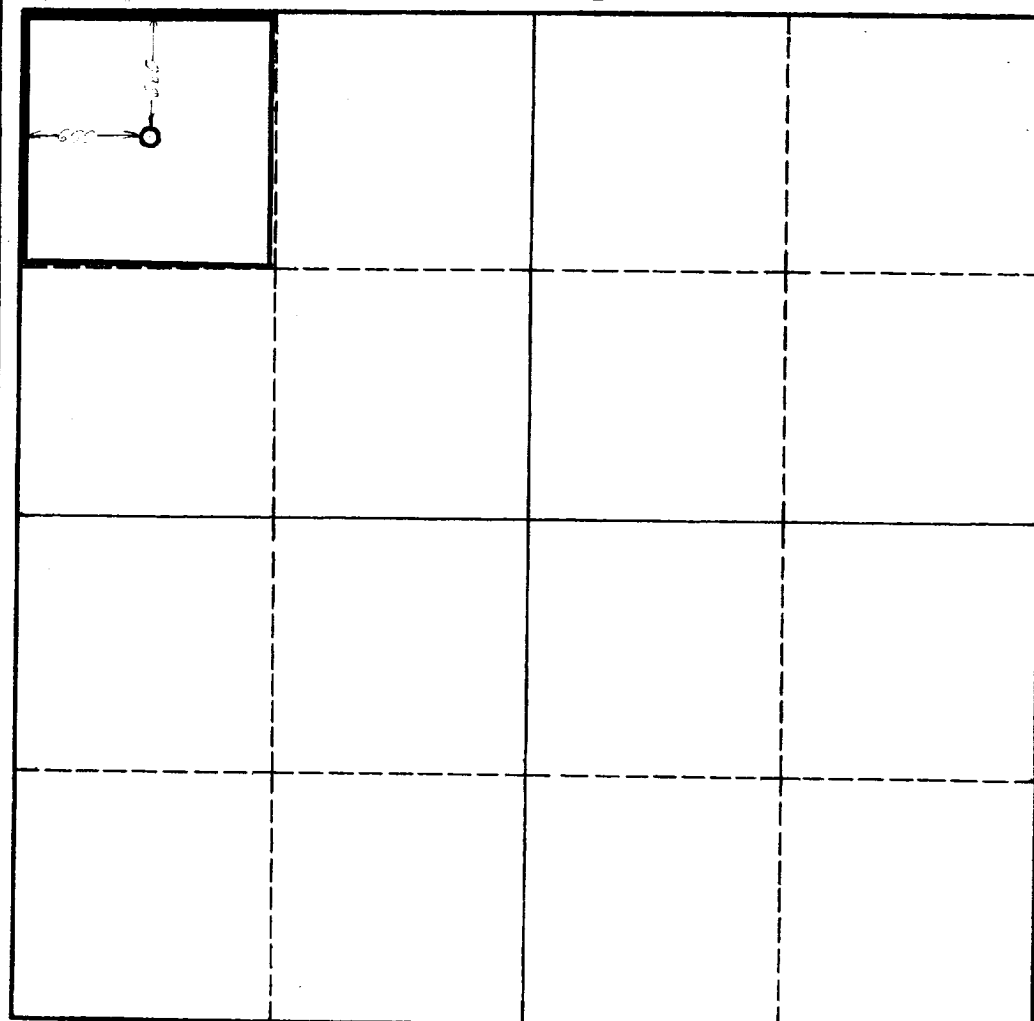
