DETAILS OF WORK

On March 16, 1957 we ran 528' of 10 3/4" CG 32.75# and then ran 23 casing to 536' and cemented with 50 sac cement.

After allowing to stand cemented 72 hours we drilled plug bailed hole dry and re-ran bailer.

As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Co.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
