The intermediate (7") casing will be pulled prior to cementing the production (5 1/2") casing. The amount of cement on the production string may be altered, but sufficient cement will be used to protect the salt zone from the Red Sand water.

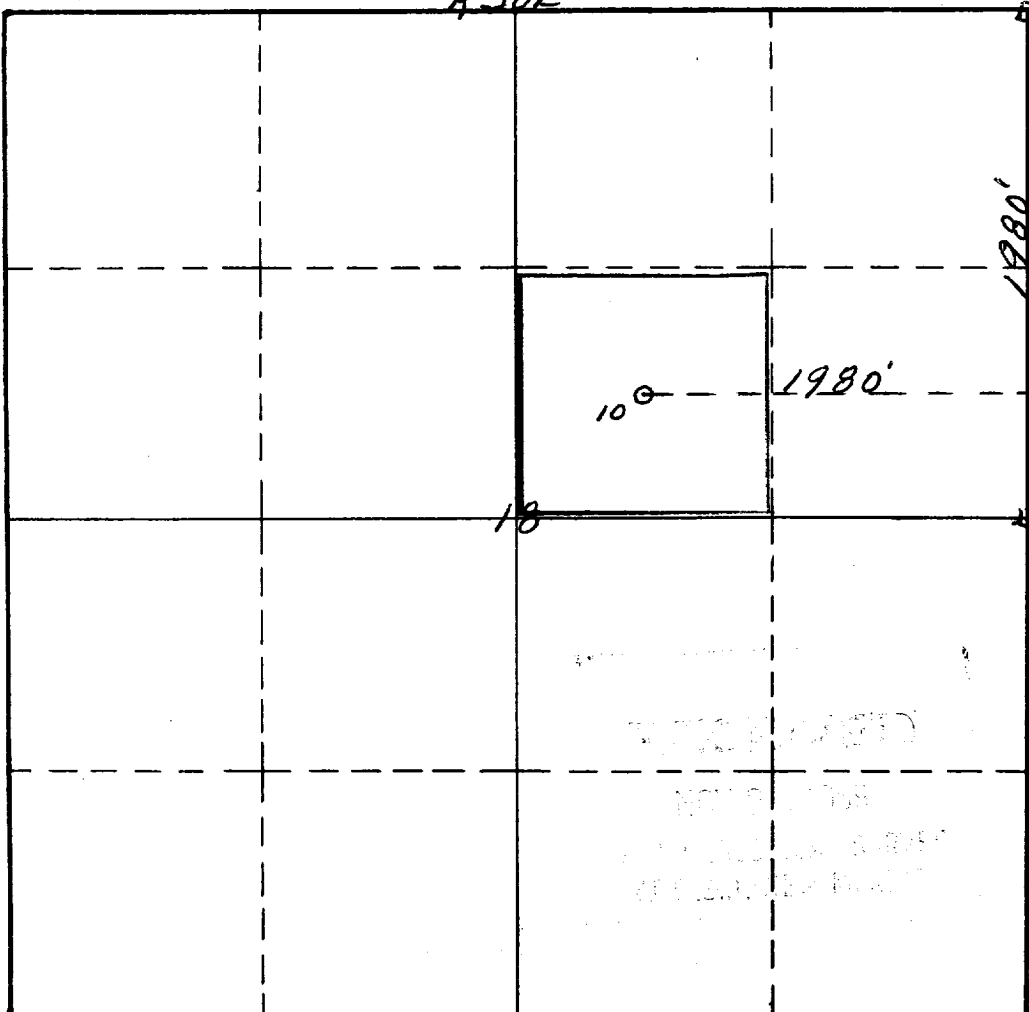
