The 8 5/8" casing will be pulled prior to cementing the 7" casing. The 10 3/4" casing will be pulled after cementing the production casing. Prior to pulling the 10 3/4" casing 50 sx. cement will be pumped into the annulus between the 10 3/4" and 7" casing.

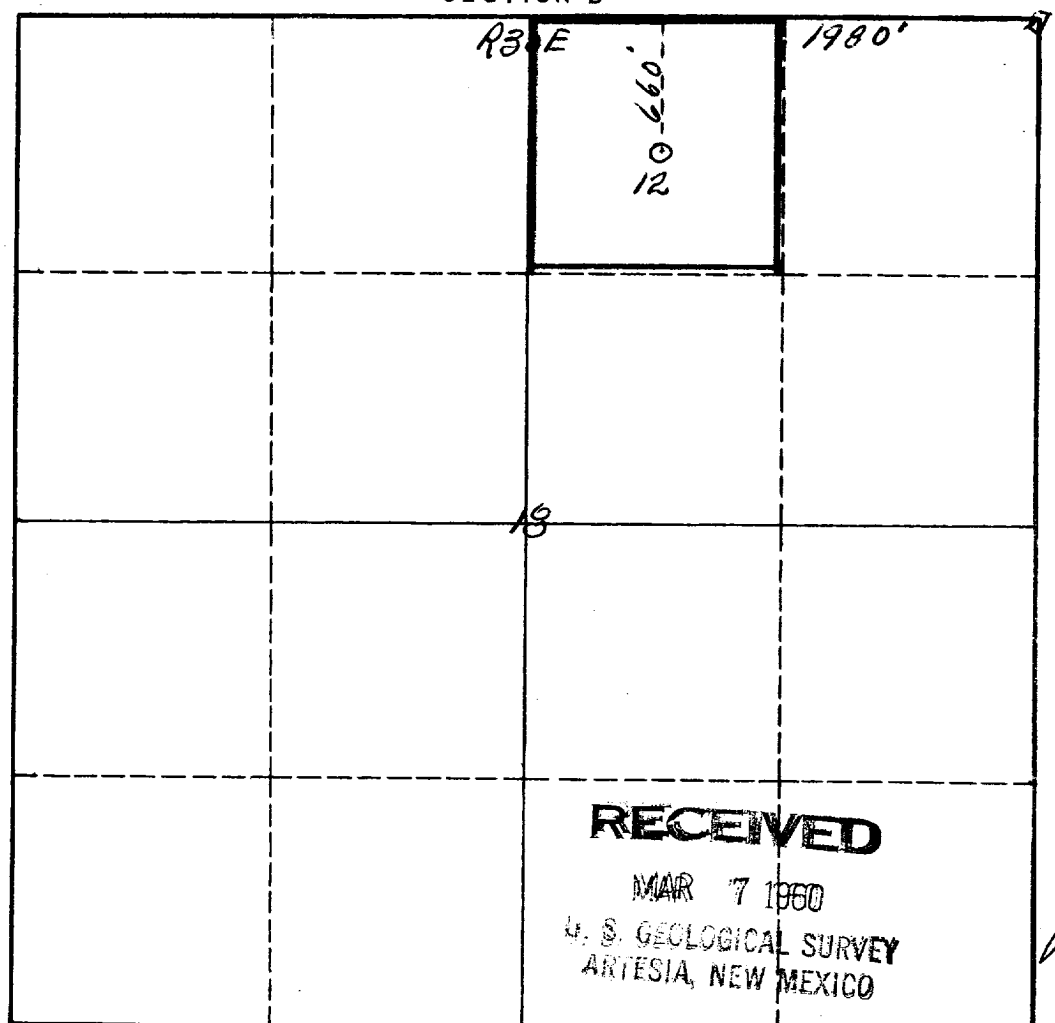
