Gentlemen:

Please accept this as Shell Oil Company's request for a special testing allowable of 3000 barrels of condensate for Shell Henshaw Deep Unit 1, located 660' FNL and 1980' FWL of Section 24, T-16-S, R-30-E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Henshaw Deep Unit 1 was drilled as a 13,000 foot Ellenburger wildcat. We are currently completing as a Devonian gas condensate discovery thru perforations 11,680-11,696 feet. On last 5 1/2 hour test subject well flowed 6.15 million cubic feet of gas per day plus 415 barrels of 62 gravity condensate per day. We plan to continue testing at various rates in order to arrive at a calculated absolute open flow potential. After this initial testing we will probably acidize and then run another series of tests. In order to accomplish this testing it will be necessary to move approximately 3000 barrels of condensate. The McWood Corporation will be the transporter.

Your early approval of this request will be appreciated.
