

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

WFX 473

That the applicant, Stallworth Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Grayburg and San Andres formations through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer at approximately 2975 feet in the following described well for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Etz Well No. 3 located in Unit J of Section 25,  
Township 16 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy  
County, New Mexico.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the operator shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval and is not permitted to escape to other formations or onto the surface.

That the casing-tubing annulus shall be loaded with an inert fluid and equipped with a pressure gauge at the surface of left open to the atmosphere to facilitate detection of leakage in the casing, tubing, or packer.

That the injection well or system shall be equipped with a pop-off valve or device which will limit the wellhead pressure of a maximum of 595 pounds per square inch; provided however that the Division Director may administratively authorize a pressure limitation in excess of the above upon the operator's establishing that such higher pressure will not result in fracturing of confining strata.

That the operator shall notify the supervisor of the Division's Artesia District Office before injection is commenced through said well;

That the operator shall immediately notify the Supervisor of the Division's Artesia District Office of the failure of the tubing, casing, or packer in said well or the leakage of water from or around said well and shall take such steps as may be timely or necessary to correct such failure or leakage.
