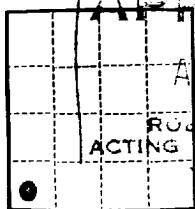

Drill with cable tools to 3100'. Set 8-5/8" casing @ 550' and cement with 50 sacks. Set 7" casing @ 2300' with mud. Pull 7" casing and set 5-1/2" casing @ 3100' and cement with 200 sacks. Perforate Grayburg sand and fracture.

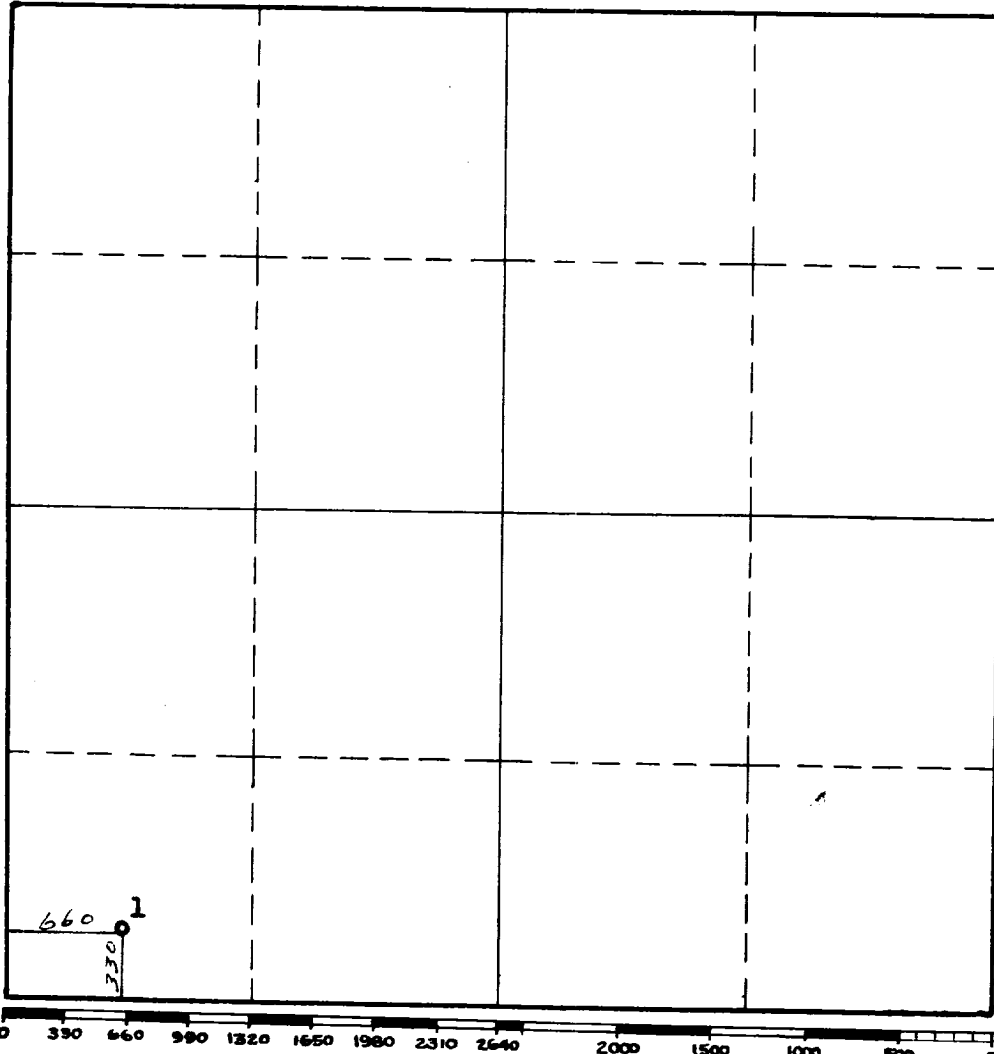
