

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: WFX 480 5-6-77

That the applicant, La Brea and Muncy, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Precifer Zone of the Grayburg Formation through plastic-lined tubing set in packers at approximately 2570 feet, 2600 feet, 2655 feet and 2689 feet, respectively, in the following described wells for purposes of secondary recovery, to wit:

Dekalb Federal Well No. 3, located in Unit J;
Dekalb Federal Well No. 1, located in Unit P;
Etz Federal Well No. 1, located in Unit L; and
Trigg Federal Well No. 3, located in Unit F;

all in Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, N24E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the operator shall take all steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval and is not permitted to escape to other formations or onto the surface.

That the casing-tubing annulus shall be loaded with an inert fluid and equipped with a pressure gauge at the surface or left open to the atmosphere to facilitate detection of leakage in the casing, tubing, or packer.

That injection pressures shall not exceed 545 pounds per square inch as measured at the surface.

That the operator shall immediately notify the supervisor of the Commission's Artesia District Office before injection is commenced through said well.

That the operator shall immediately notify the supervisor of the Commission's Artesia Office of the failure of the tubing, casing, or packer in said well or the leakage of water from or around said well and shall take such steps as may be timely or necessary to correct such failure or leakage.
