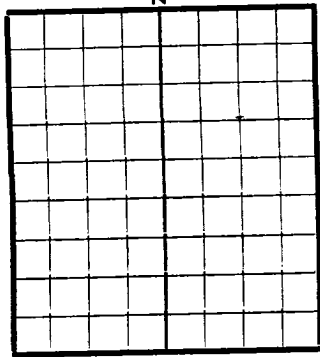

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3000 feet.

Additional information: 100' of 8 1/4" liner will be cemented in red sand formation found at approximately 2200' - Cemented with sufficient amount of cement to cement entire liner. This is very successful on Government land in same area.
