- April 22, 1942 - Run 475' of 10" casing, cemented with 50 sacks cement by International Cementers, Inc.
- April 25, 1942 - Drilled plug, tested complete shut-off, continued drilling encountered water again from 500' to 515'.
- April 27, 1942 - Run 621' of 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Casing, cemented with 50 sacks cement.
- May 1, 1942 - Drilled plug, continued drilling with complete water shut-off.
