Effective May 1, 1965, the allowable of the following Newmont Oil Co., wells in the pools listed below are hereby revised as indicated:

SQUARE LAKE

Itz C #4-O, 34-16-30, increased from 5 to 15 bbls daily or 465 bbls for the month.

Itz E #4-A, 34-16-30, increased from 3 to 5 bbls daily or 155 bbls for the month.

Leonard #11-H, 34-16-30, increased from 15 to 25 bbls or 775 bbls for the month.

WLFU Tr.#3, 1,3-C, 12-18-29, increased from 220 to 320 bbls daily or 9920 bbls for the month.

WLFU Tr.#40, 1,2-H, 1-18-29, increased from 350 to 400 bbls daily or 12400 bbls for the month.

WLFU Tr.#1, 3-L, 7-18-30, increased from 350 to 450 bbls daily or 13950 bbls for the month.

WLFU Tr.#38, 2-H, 2-18-29, increased from 420 to 440 bbls daily or 13640 bbls for the month.

WLFU Tr.#38, 4-B, 2-18-29, increased from 50 to 80 bbls daily or 2480 bbls for the month.

WLFU Tr.#39 3-J, 2-18-29, increased from 50 to 80 bbls daily or 2480 bbls for the month.
