Please find enclosed herewith your approved copies of Oil Conservation Commission Forms C-110 indicating change of transporter for wells in the Square Lake Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

We do not agree with the change of unit letter which you have shown for the No. 1 and No. 2 wells on the Etz "EW" lease in Section 34-16S-30E. I have checked with the district office of the U. S. Geological Survey here in Artesia and their records show the No. 1 well in Unit "G" and the No. 2 well in Unit "H". The district engineer further states that if you intend to switch the well numbers, then you will have to obtain permission from their office. Also we have corrected the name of the transporter to Artesia Pipe Line Company which is owned by Malco Asphalt and Refining Company.
