DETAILS OF WORK

This well was plugged and abandoned on 11/11/50 by Lea County
 Casing Failure of Hobbs, New Mexico. Work was done in the following manner:
 From a total amount of 520' of surface pipe 171' was recovered, leaving 349'
 in the hole. This pipe was filled with heavy mud and a cement plug of 10
 sacks of cement was placed at top of salt. From 2820' of oil casing 900'
 was recovered leaving 1920' in the hole. This pipe was filled with heavy
 mud and a cement plug was set with 10 sacks. Hole was filled with heavy
 mud and a cement regulation marker was set and well was abandoned.
