DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well has a total depth of 3040'. Of 2396' of oil string, 990' was left in hole. Heavy mud was run from bottom to 1406' where pipe was salvaged and a cement plug of 15 sacks was set. Heavy mud was run to bottom of surface pipe at 545' and cement plug of 5 sacks was set and heavy mud run to surface. A cement plug of 5 sacks was set; regulation marker placed and location cleared.
