DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well has a total depth of 3107'. Of 2455' of oil string 1833' was left in hole. Heavy mud was run from bottom to 662' where pipe was salvaged and a cement plug of 15 sacks was set. Heavy mud was run to bottom to surface pipe at 465' and cement plug of 5 sacks was set and heavy mud run to surface. A cement plug of 5 sacks was set; regulation marker was placed and location cleared.
