DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was plugged and abandoned on 11/7/50. Work was done in the following manner: From a total amount of 545 feet of surface pipe, 143 feet was recovered, leaving 402 feet in the hole. This pipe was filled with heavy mud and a cement plug of 10 sacks was set. From 2396 feet of oil string, 2029 feet was recovered, leaving 367 feet in the hole. This pipe was filled with heavy mud and a cement plug was set with 10 sacks of cement. Cement marker was placed according to regulations and well was abandoned. Well was plugged by Lea County Casing Pullers of Hobbs, New Mexico.
