

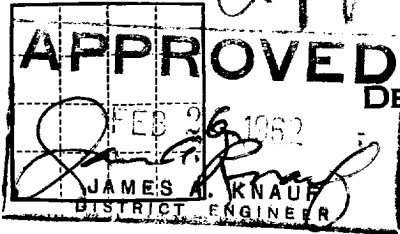

DETAILS OF WORK

I plan to drill a 3800' Grayburg sand test with rotary tools.

We propose to cement 8 5/8" surface casing at approximately 1000' with 100 sacks.

We will cement a 4 1/2" oil string through any pay sands at approximately 3760' with 200 sacks.

All casing will be run and cemented using methods approved by the U.S.G.S.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

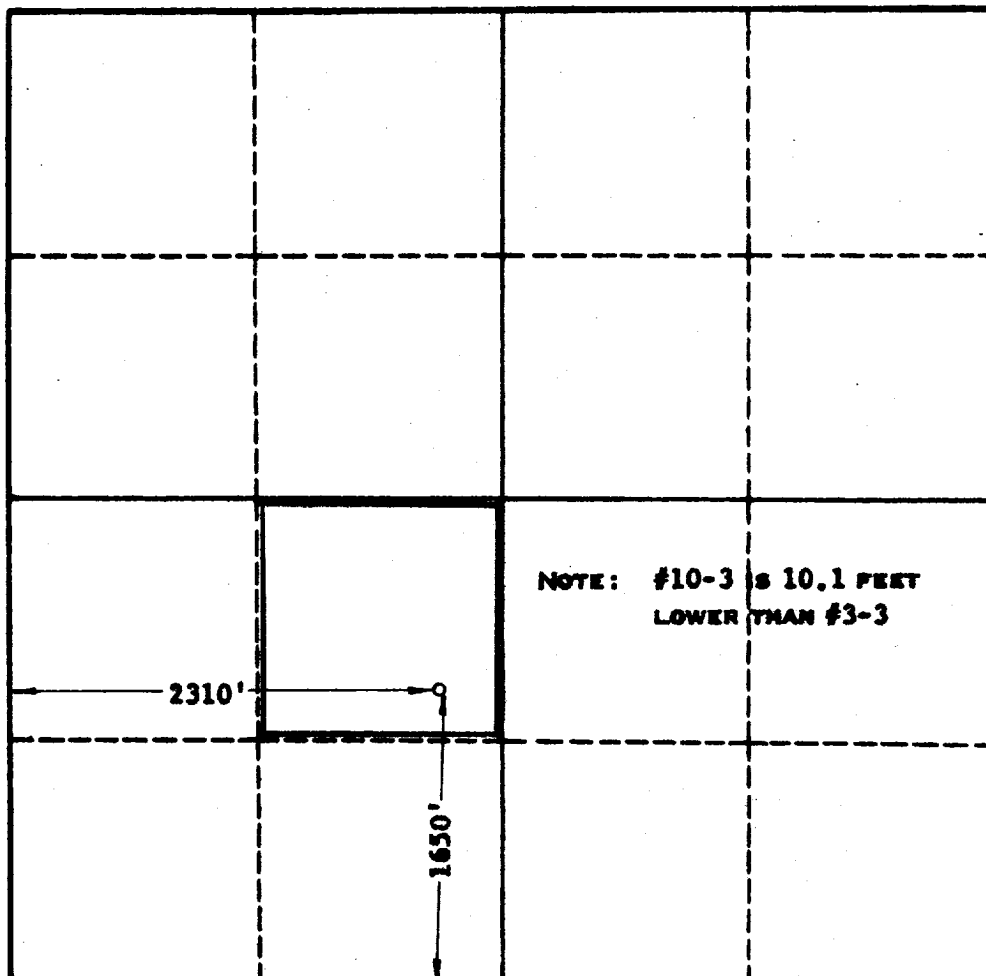
