Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of Form C-116, "Gas-Oil Test Report" for your well in the North Square Lake Pool. We notice some differences between these test GORs as reported on Form C-116 and on the actual production GORs as calculated from the production reported by you on Commission Form C-115. These differences are as follows:
