DETAILS OF WORK

The subject well had been pumped intermittently during June, July, August, September, and October of 1962, recovering lead oil. On November 3, 1962 rods and tubing were pulled and the pumping unit was removed. The well is now standing pending studies to consider secondary recovery. Total lead oil not recovered, 2061 barrels.
