DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

This well was drilled to total depth of 3512' without encountering commercial production of oil or gas, and has been abandoned, plugging as follows. Hole was filled with heavy mud and the following cement plugs spotted: 30 sacks, 2985'-2885', and 30 sacks, 2710'-2630' (in bottom of 8-5/8" casing). The 8-5/8" casing was parted and pulled at 1216' and a 20-sack cement plug spotted in top of parted 8-5/8" casing from 1240' to 1180'. A cement plug of 20 sacks was spotted from 780' to 740' (in bottom of 10-3/4" casing, near top of salt). The 10-3/4" casing was parted and pulled at approximately 296', and the customary 4" pipe marker was cemented in the top of the hole with 20 sacks of cement. The above work was completed 11-14-44, and the location is now cleaned up and ready for inspection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
