3276 (corrected).

Re-logged hole with Gamma Ray Neutron and Acoustilog logs

Fraced Lovington zone 3228-3233 through 2 1/2" tubing with packers set at 3175' with
390 barrels of water and 15,000 #'s 20-40 sand

Sand bridged to 3150 and abrasijetted at 3132, 3124, 3114 and 3105 1/2 and fraced with
1,000 barrels water, 40,000 #'s 20-40 sand and 1,000 #'s rock salt

Sand bridged to 3058 and abrasijetted at 3047, 3044, 3025 and 3021 and fraced with
1,000 barrels water, 32,000 #'s 20-40 sand and 1,000 #'s rock salt

Abrasijetted 2695 and 2691, fraced with 320 barrels water and 10,000 #'s 20-40 sand
Circulated sand from hole to T.D. and placed on production

Prior production: 1 BOPD + 1 BOPD pumping

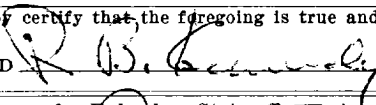

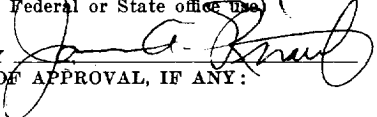

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL, IF ANY:

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
