Intend to perforate well from 3098-3104, 3091-95, and 3140-51 with 2 holes/ft. Will run 1 1/2" tubing with 2 7/8" packer and acidize zone from 3140-51 and then from 3091-3104 selectively and test each for injectivity rate. If satisfactory rate is not achieved will treat each zone selectively with 7,500 gal gelled water and 5,000# sand. Well will then be washed out and completed as a water injection well in the Grier waterflood project, pending administrative approval. Intend to set 1 1/2" tubing and packer to selectively inject into zone from 3273-3378 through tubing and through the annulus into zones 3091-3154.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
