PURPOSE: ALLOWABLE REVISION (WATERFLOOD)

Effective July 1, 1964, the allowable of the Newmont Oil Co., Carper G. #3-J, 29-16-31, Square Lake Pool is hereby increased from 75 barrels daily to 90 barrels daily or a total of 2790 barrels for the month.
