PURPOSE: ALLOWABLE ASSIGNMENT (SECOND MONTH)

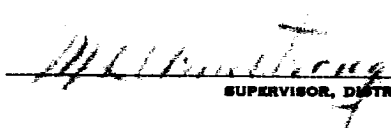
