Gentlemen:

On June 30, 1982, Southland Royalty Company received approval from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to change the above captioned well from the Robinson Unit Tr. 4 No. 36-16 to the State "RC" No. 3. Also on this date, the NMOCD approved Southland's permit to plug back the subject well to the Queen formation. Since that time, the well was plugged back and tested in the Queen formation but was unable to produce.

Southland Royalty Company is now requesting approval to assign this well back to the Robinson Unit Tr. 4 No. 36-16 to attempt restoring production in the Maljamar (Grayburg-San Andres) pool.
