Please find attached herewith your approved copies of Form C-103 and C-110; also, Form C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug the above captioned well.

You will note that I have made an exception to your proposed plugging program. Here in New Mexico we request that a cement plug be placed at the top and base of the salt section in all plugging operations in addition to the plugs that you have outlined in your notice. The reason for these plugs is to protect the salt section from any contamination or encroachment of water. Also, this method affords better protection to the vast potash mining operations that are carried on here in Eddy County.

Before your Report of Final Plugging will be approved you must file six copies of Form C-105, Well Log, fill and level the slush pits and clear the location of all junk and erect the regulation dry hole marker.
