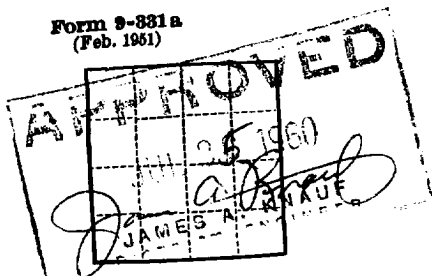

DETAILS OF WORK

Ran 980' of 8 5/8" casing and mudded. Pulled 499' of 10 3/4" casing. Test showed water shut-off.
Plugged and abandoned well on March 28, 1960 as follows: Pulled 980' of 8 5/8" casing. Filled hole with heavy mud. Spotted cement plugs from 1715' to 1815'; 1000' to 1100' and 560' to 725'. This witnessed by State Water Engineer.
Regulation marker set in five sack cement plug on May 23, 1960, after rig was removed from location. Location cleaned up.

Electric logs were not run on this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
