5/12/65 Pulled casing. Ran tubing, stopped @ 4920'. Pulled tubing to 4820'. Plugged with 50 sack. Expected fill to 4667'. Hung tubing @ 3275' and plugged with 45 sack. Expected fill to 3125'. Hung tubing @ 1008'. Plugged with 90 sack Regular + 25 CaCl. Felt for cement and found @ 918'. Hung tubing @ 910'. Plugged with 100 sack Regular + 25 CaCl. Felt for plug and found @ 870'. USGS representative cased plugs.

5/13/65 Hung tubing @ 30' and plugged with 30 sack. Completed surface plug 41' KB to bottom of collar or top of 13-3/8" casing. Erected dry hole marker. Cut dead man anchors. Waiting for pits to dry to clean up lease.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
