2. Set BP at 8725' and capped w/4' 20-40 mesh sand.
3. Perforated 8664', 8691', 8697', 8705', 8714', and 8718' with 1-3/8" JSPF (total 6 holes).
4. Ran 2" tubing with Baker Model "R" packer, with retrievable head on bottom.
5. Treated perforated interval 8664'-8718' with 1400 gals. 15% NEA using 6 ball sealers.
6. Recovered 62 bbls. oil over load.
7. Retreated perforated interval 8714'-8718' with 1000 gals. 15% NEA.
8. Recovered load.
9. In 24 hours flowed 216 BO + 10 BW on 17/64" choke. TP 580 psi.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
