**DETAILS OF WORK**

Well was cored from 3385' to 3700' from RKB measurement. On the night of December 17th and morning of December 18, Schlumberger ran gamma-ray, sonic, lateral and microlateral logs to a Total Depth of 3689' from ground level measurement. Rig was released and moved off the morning of December 18, 1962. The well will be completed after the Christmas holidays. We will forward logs and core analysis when available. Oil string has not been run at this time. We are waiting upon core analysis, electric logs and additional information before making the decision whether to attempt completion or plug said well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
