## DETAILS OF WORK

Plugged back & ran 3 1/2" casing at 1466 - cemented with 100 sacks.  
Ran electric log and perforated 1449-43 & 1419-13 (48 holes)  
Treated through perforations with 30,000 lbs. sand and 550 bbls. water  
Well tested one quart of oil on 30 minute bailing test natural  
Tests approximately 15 B.O.P.D. after frac water flowed back.  
Moved off and cleaned up location.
