In order to maintain your leasehold production status, this is to advise that Phillips will take a maximum of 50 Mcf/Day of produced gas from the Atlantic State No. 1 on March 16 and 17, 1985. It is understood that this production will be sufficient to hold your lease for the 90-day production periods ending March 16, 1985 and June 14, 1985.
