On March 12, 1967 this well (the old Shell Oil Co. Marshaw Deep Unit Well No. 15) was re-entered to plug back depth of 3216'.

On March 14, 1967 well was perforated 3098-18, 4 SPF, and frac'd with 20,000# sand.

On March 16, 1967 well was perforated 2965-78, 4 SPF, and frac'd with 20,000# sand.

512' of 11-1/2" surface pipe and 3098' of 8-5/8" casing were in the hole; on June 16, 1967 5-1/2" casing liner was set and cemented from 3046 to 3216' with 65 sx.

On June 21, 1967 the liner was perforated from 3156 to 3170', 4 SPF, and was frac'd with 15,000# sand.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
