This altered casing program pursuant to oral approval from Knauf on November 23, 1967.

Drilled to 1630', Cored 1580' to 1630'. Sand 1584 to 1595.

Ran 456 feet of 7" casing, cemented with 200 sacks in 4 stages. Stage 1, 100 sacks by pump around shoe. Stage 2, 50 sacks in top. Stage 3, 30 sacks in top. Stage 4, 20 sacks in top.

Ran 4 1/2", 9.5#/ft, J-55 Casing set @ 1626'. Cemented with 100 sacks.

Perforated 1584 to 1595 with 40 holes

Treated with 1000 Gallons regular 15% acid.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
