SHERRELL, AMERICAN MANUFACTURERS MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY, AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY THE FLOYD SHERRELL WELL NO. 1 LOCATED IN UNIT K OF SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, EDDY COUNTY, SHOULD NOT BE PLUGGED AND ABANDONED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A DIVISION-APPROVED PLUGGING PROGRAM:

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

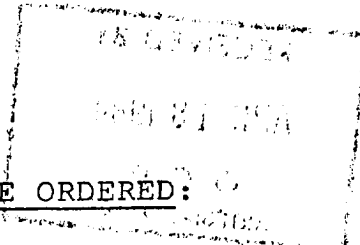
BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on March 14, 1984, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 2nd day of April, 1984, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That Floyd E. Sherrell is the owner and operator of the Floyd Sherrell Well No. 1, located in Unit K of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That American Manufacturers Mutual Insurance Company is the surety on the Oil Conservation Division plugging bond on which Floyd E. Sherrell is principal.
- (4) That the purpose of said bond is to assure the state that the subject well will be properly plugged and abandoned when not capable of commercial production.
- (5) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said well should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by the Artesia District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on or before June 1, 1984, or the well should be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.



IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That Floyd E. Sherrell and American Manufacturers Mutual Insurance Company are hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Floyd Sherrell Well No. 1, located in Unit K of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, or in the alternative, to return the well to active drilling status or place the well on production on or before June 1, 1984.

(2) That Floyd E. Sherrell and American Manufacturers Mutual Insurance Company, prior to plugging and abandoning the above-described well, shall obtain from the Artesia office of the Division, a Division-approved program for said plugging and abandoning, and shall notify said Artesia office of the date and hour said work is to be commenced whereupon the Division may, at its option, witness such work.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


