Dear Sir:

Pan American Petroleum Corporation's Trigg "B" Federal Well No. 1 was completed on 10-31-68 in the Morrow Formation as a flowing gas well. Since the well was a Wildcat and there are no immediate sales connection points, negotiations are now in progress for a gas sales contract.

Testing the well's potential at the present time could only be accomplished by venting the gas to the atmosphere. It is doubtful that a pipeline connection can be accomplished within 30 days after completion of the well, therefore an extension of the 30 days time limitation in Rule 401 is requested until such a connection is made. This will prevent revenue loss due to gas venting and test equipment rental, and will allow us to obtain better test data since the 1 hour flow period restriction for each point does not apply to connected wells. When the well has been connected to a gas gathering system, compliance to Rule 401 will be made.
