12-17-70 - Spudded 12:45 P.M. 12-17-70.
12-19-70 - TD 120'. Ran 100' of 10 3/4" conductor pipe and cemented 2/50 sacks of Neat cement. P.D. 8 P.M. 12-19-70. The hole had been caving in, difficult to circulate grave. Circulated 15 sacks of cement to pit (35 sacks to gravel beds behind pipe). WOC 24 hours and resumed drilling.

This pipe was intended to be pulled when surface casing is run, but due to excessive gravel caving we decided it feasible to cement the conductor pipe instead of mudding up.
