1. That he is Vice President (Title) of Coquina Oil Corporation (Operator) whose address is P. O. Drawer 2960, Midland, Texas 79702.
2. That Coquina Oil Corporation (Operator) is the operator of a well drilled on land belonging to Blaine B.
