J. T. Berry, being first duly sworn according to law, upon his oath deposes and says:

1. That he is Superintendent of Coquina Oil Corporation

2. That Coquina Oil Corporation is the operator of a well drilled on land be-

longing to Blaine B. Haines, whose address is Artesia, New Mexico

3. Blaine B. Haines, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the Blaine No. 1, being located 660 feet from the N line and 1980 feet from the E line of Section 14, Township 17S, Range 26 E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 8803 feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows: 12 3/4" @ 500', cemented with 350 sxs. TLW 1/4# Flocele, 2% calcium chloride; and 8 5/8" @ 1428.80', cemented with 150 sxs. to bottom and 450 sxs. outside of TLW 1/4# Flocele, 2% calcium chloride.
4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement whereby operator (is) (~~is not~~) to back fill pits, level location, and clear it of all junk. The agreement further provides that operator is to plug said well back to a plugged-back total depth of 1375 feet and transfer well to landowner for his use as a water-well. Operator will leave casing in the well as follows: Same as in Item 3.
5. That when operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above it will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Form C-103, together with a signed statement from the landowner that the provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.
