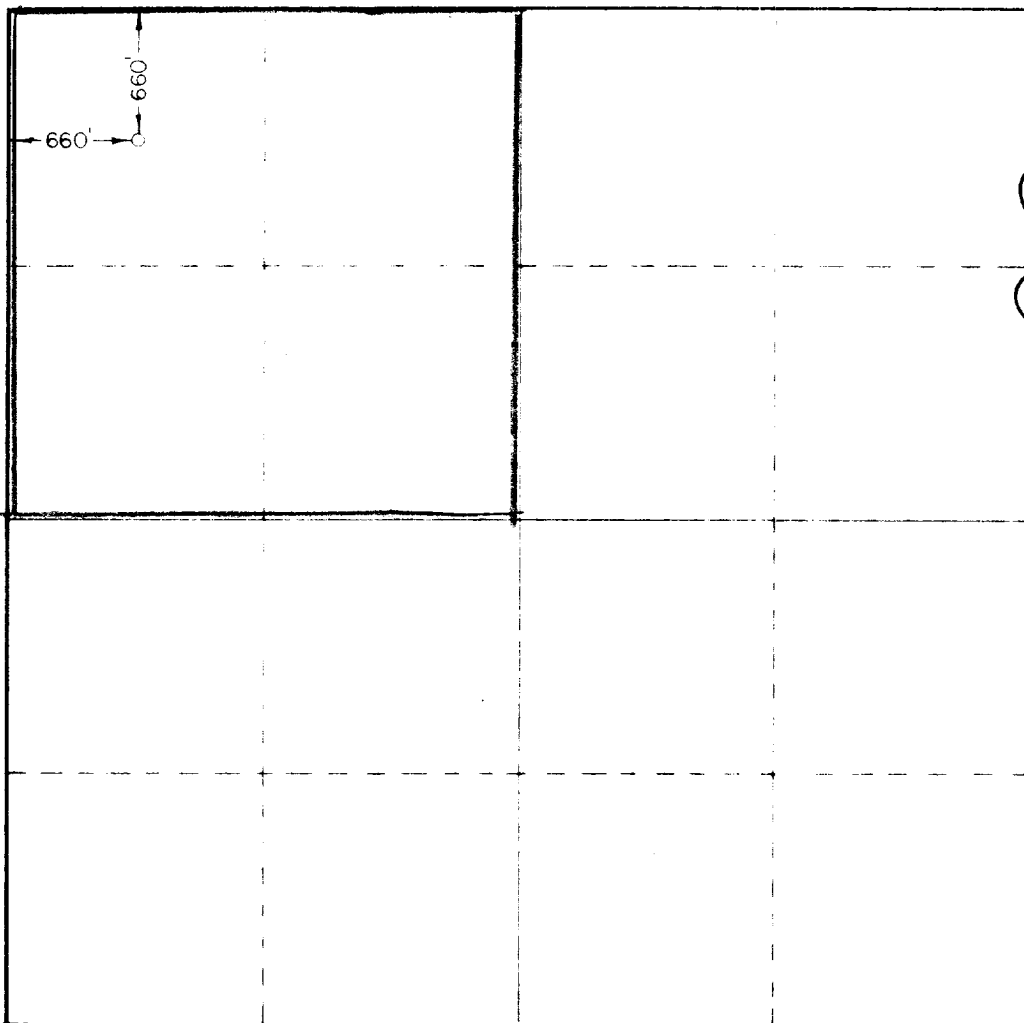

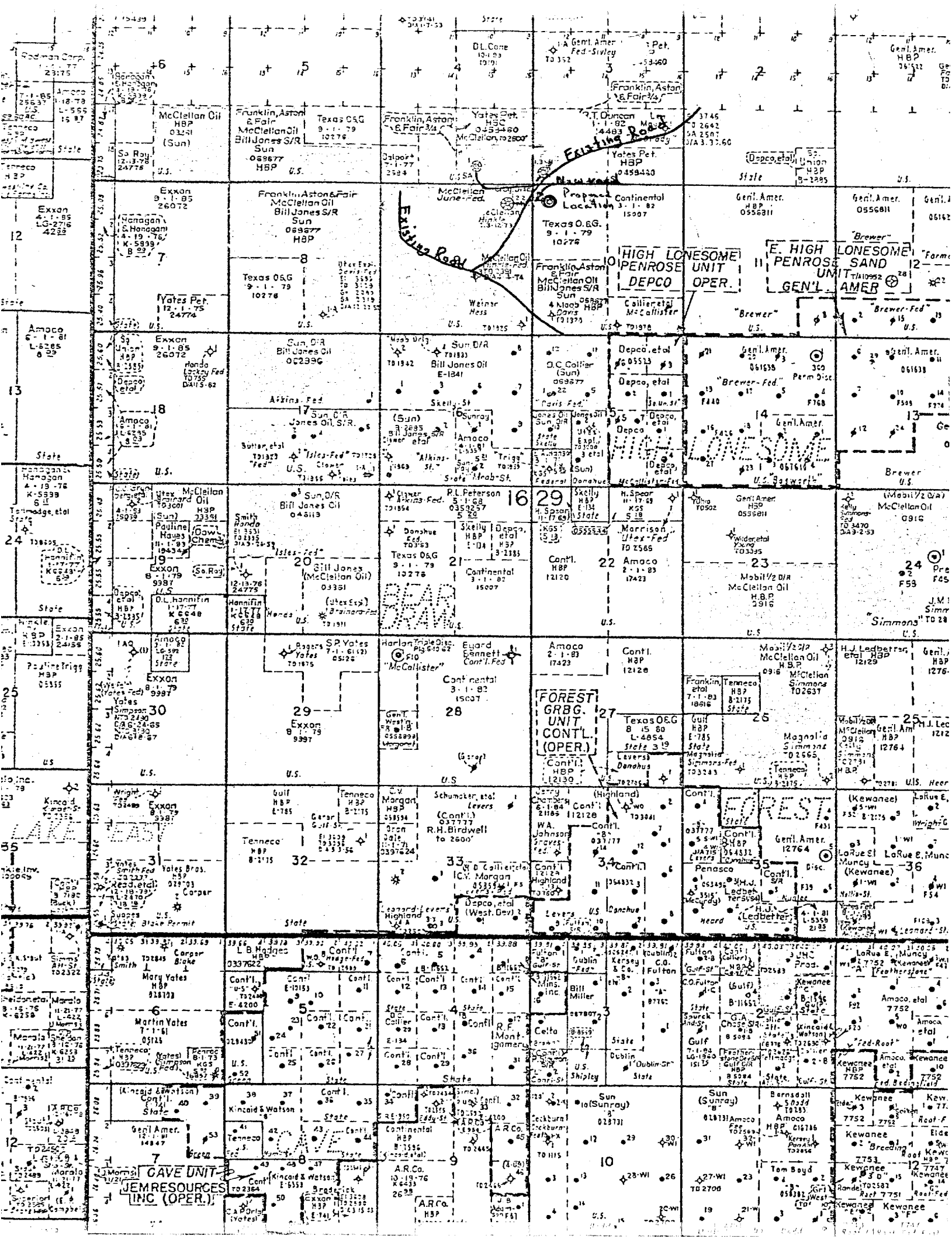

The following is a Plan of Development for Surface use required to drill the proposed well attached to this application:

1. Federal Highway 82 is approximately 8 miles South of the proposed location.
2. The proposed road will be the only road into the proposed drillsite. Approximately 200' of road will be constructed.
3. It is possible that other roads will be necessary to the North and West if this test is successful.
4. The production, if achieved, will be connected in to an existing pipeline.
5. Drilling water will have to be trucked in as there is no source of fresh water in this area.
6. After completion of drilling operations all waste will be buried in a separate pit or hauled away.
7. Any produced brine water will be removed by truck in order to prevent contamination of any possible fresh water bearing sands in this area.
8. Application for connection will be made immediately upon completion, if any gas is encountered.
9. An attached development plat indicates location layout, rig plan, etc.
10. In the event a dry hole is achieved, all pits will be filled and the location restored, as near as possible to its original condition.
11. If production is achieved, pad and roads will remain in effect however pits will be filled and restored, as near as possible, to their original condition.

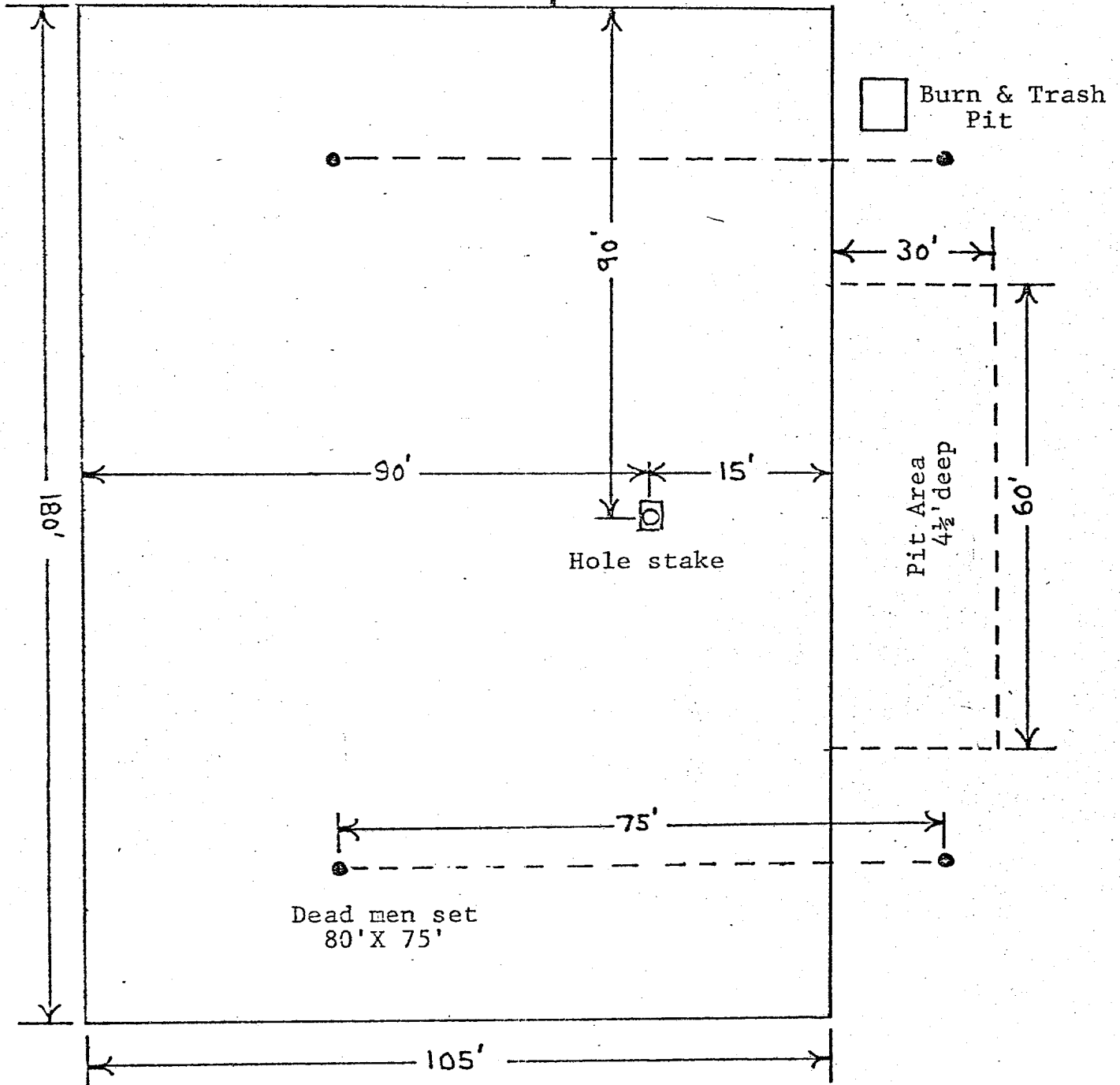
