hereby requests an exception to Rule 306 for 60 days or until

TUCO, INC.


D. Distance 1/4 mile Estimated cost of connection Unknown **OCT 22 1976**

E. This exception is requested for the following reasons:

1. We are negotiating with TUCO, INC. to encompass gas produced from this well into their existing line which, however, will necessitate a large amount of compression.
2. We are negotiating with Phillips Petroleum to lay a low pressure line into this area to gather gas from this well and also take gas from 2 existing shutin gas wells.

We anticipate that we should have a decision by one or both these Companies within 60 days.
