

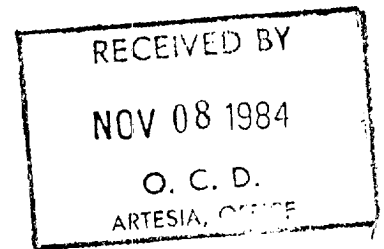

Reference is made to your request of October 31, 1984 and our notice of gas well gas proration dated September 4, 1984.

In order to maintain your leasehold production status, this is to advise that Phillips will take a maximum of 50 Mcf/Day of produced gas from each of the captioned wells on November 16, 1984. It is understood that the production on November 16, 1984, will be sufficient to hold your individual leases for the November, 1984 production period. In addition, a like amount of production will be accepted on the same day of each subsequent month during this period of gas well production curtailment.

It is requested that you contact Don Laird - Artesia Plant Superintendent (505) 677-3154 prior to the designated production dates in order to coordinate the flowing of the referenced wells under these criteria.
