## Terrain

Tonographically, the investigated area is situated on an undulating plain lying west of the Llano Estacado. Coppice dunes in the area range between 2 and 5 m but usually average less than 4 m. Associated deflation basins measuring to 6 m in breadth, are generally circular and sometimes open-ended. Several small subsidence structures occur locally. Soils in subsidence areas are sandy clay loams belonging to the Typic Eaplargid subgroup where as peds in dunal areas are sandy loams and loamy sands belonging to several intergrades of the Typic Torripsamment subgroup. Small, granular-sized caliche inclusions occur in these latter soils.

## Floristics

The areal overstory is formed mainly by <u>Artemisia filofolia</u>, <u>Ouercus havardii and Yucca glauca</u>. A few specimens of <u>Prosopis</u> <u>juliflore and Chrysothamnus pulchellus</u> occur in the investigated area as does <u>Sanindus drummondii</u> which is rare. The grasses are represented by <u>Aristida spp., Sporobolus sp., Stipa neomexicana</u>, <u>Andropogon glomeratus</u>, <u>Tridens pulchellus</u>, <u>Bouteloua eriopoda</u> and <u>Cenchrus incertus</u>. <u>Setaria macrostachya</u> occurs in associ-
