Enclosed please find NMAS' Archaeological Clearance Report for General American Oil Company of Texas' proposed Stablien Well No.8, its access road, and the modificiation to the existing ranch road. Excepting a chert utilized flake and several pieces of chert debitage on the location, cultural resources were not encountered. Observed remains, while not diagnotic, represent the end-product of <u>en passant</u> activities and are termed isolated manifestations. NMAS is suggesting clearance.
