

11. OTHER INFORMATION cont.....:

- E. Residences and other Structures: There are no residences in the vicinity of the proposed well. The only structure is the Dog Canyon Well (windmill) approximately one mile southwest of the location as shown on the topographic map Exhibit "B".
- F. Land Use: Cattle Grazing.
- G. Surface Ownership: Federal surface and minerals.
- H. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical or cultural sites in the area. An archaeological survey has been conducted by New Mexico Archaeological Services, Inc., P.O. Box 1341, Carlsbad, New Mexico 88220, and their report has been submitted to the appropriate government agencies.
- I. The appropriate Right of Way owners and surface leaseholder have been notified of this application and the crossing of their property.
